You will see a slight reduction in the storm charge portion of vour bill as part of a routine adjustment effective this month. The charge, a portion of your bill that helps pay for previous hurricane restoration costs and helps to build the reserve for future storms, adjusts periodically throughout the year following Florida Public Service Commission approval. 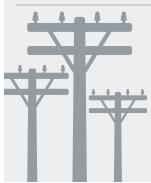
