





What do the colorcoded flags mean?

- White: Proposed excavation
- Pink: Temporary survey markings
- Red: Electric power lines, cables, conduit and lighting cables
 - Yellow: Gas, oil, steam, petroleum or gaseous materials
- Orange: Communication, alarm or signal lines, cables or conduit
- Blue: Potable water
- Purple: Reclaimed water, irrigation and slurry lines
- Green: Sewers and drain lines
